## A hands-on, front-line placement

Working with clients 1-to-1 at home and/or in the community to provide flexible, person-centred support to meet the complexity a person experiences in their day-to-day life

**★** Hosting community activities

Co-hosting established community activities, such as a walking group, community cafe, or creative therapy group; and designing and leading your very own short-term community project!

X Supporting with administrative tasks

Develop the office skills that go alongside front-line client work: keeping up with communications from others in the community & team, recording notes from any client or community work, auditing records, researching other support options and planning/reviewing sessions.

\* Leading and sharing learning

Develop your leadership skills as you progress through your placement, coleading learning spaces for other students

#### SUPERVISION AND TRAINING


Our placement is all about providing the best learning opportunity possible so that you can hit the ground running in your career. You will:
